Good morning and thank you for agreeing to meet with us today and taking time out of your busy schedule.

We have a few questions for you and if you don't mind, we will take notes of your answers.

Question 1.

When will the new school be completed?

The summer of 2027.

Question 2.

How much will the total cost of the build be?

Building: £7,200,00. Total project £9,000,000.

Question 3.

Will the whole school be on one site?

The whole school will be on the one site.

Question 4.

Will we have separate playgrounds – like P1 & P2 or P7 etc?

There will be a small infant playground. The rest of the school will share a large playground.

Question 5.

What will happen to our old school site – Cargan and Martinstown?

That is still to be decided. Cargan school is a very old building and is listed (which means it has to be protected).

Question 6.

How many classrooms in total in the new building?

There will be 9 classrooms.

Question 7.

Will there be one floor or two floors?

One floor. This will be for disability access for children and adults.

Question 8.

What rooms are there – i.e. bathrooms, dinner hall, sports hall, library?

Nine classrooms, resources area, small rooms (e.g. piano tuition), multi-purpose hall, kitchen, staffroom and administration offices.

Question 9.

Are the cloakrooms big and will they have benches and hooks/pegs?

There will be cloakrooms, with pegs and benches.

There will also be a boys' changing room and a girls' changing room. Every classroom will have its own cloakrooms and toilets.

Question 10.

Will every room have an ICT touch board?

There will be brand new ICT touch boards in all classrooms.

Question 11.

Will we have a school hall, with a stage?

There will be a multi-purpose sports hall (used at lunchtime for dinners).

A school stage will be bought by the school. It will be put up for Christmas shows etc. and then stored away for the rest of the year.

Question 12.

Will there be any mobiles attached?

No mobile classrooms.

Question 13.

Will every room have new chairs and tables, or do we take the old ones with us?

There will be brand new chairs and tables in every classroom. The old chairs and tables will be donated to local schools or dumped.

Question 14.

Will there be mirrors in the bathroom?

There will be mirrors in the toilets.

Question 15.

Will we have our own kitchen to provide dinners?

There will be a kitchen in the new school.

Any other information:-

Colours: Staff and pupils will be involved in selecting colours. Parts of the schools will be painted in different colours e.g. the infants will have their own colour.

Size of the school: Approximately 100m x 40m.
