## Phonics

1. Sounding Out Book - week 19.
2. a) Build the dog family together cat - bat, fat, hat, mat, pat, sat.
b) Read, spot sound pattern at the end of words.
c) Spot the odd one out Rhyming Game -

Call out 5 words, 4 of which rhyme - ask your child to spot the word that doesn't rhyme. Eg ; cat rat rat fish pat
d) Act it - Rhyme day or Write it - Rhyme day - act/write any cvc word. Child guesses word then acts/writes a word that rhymes. (Let your child choose which way they'd prefer to play this game.)

Extension: a) Using Rhyme laminated grid - read words, spot letter pattern. You say a word and child has to agree if this word can join list of rhyming words or not.
b)child suggests rhyming word to join each list.

## Literacy

- Wednesday a) make playdoh - follow recipe below
- Thursday Make soup together if possible

1. Cut the vegetables up
2. Put in a pot
3. Add some water
4. Put on cooker and turn on
5. Stir a little and wait
6. Eat - yummy yummy!!

- Friday Writing Book - write set of very simple instructions on how to make soup. Use instructions above to help when writing your set of instructions.

Numeracy Playdoh recipe

- 4 cups plain flour - 2 cups of salt
- 4 teasp cream of tartar $\quad-1 / 2$ cup oil
- 4 cups of water
- Make fruit/vegetable out of playdoh to sell in café shop. Keep prices low and child only allowed to pay with 1 ps .
- Daily allowance activity - Give your child a daily allowance, for instance 10p. They have to buy treats from you throughout the day. A jammy dodger could be $3 p, 15$ mins on ipad could be $2 p$, game of football/trampoline with you is $3 p$ etc... your child is in charge of their own money and have to decide how best to spend it.
- Wednesday - Intro length -language longer/shorter
- look around home and find toys/items to sort
- help mum to sort your socks longer / shorter
