Monday	<p>Recap on weekly spellings from Sounding Out Book. Please begin on weeks 4-6.</p> <p>Write out all spellings. Then choose 3 words and write 3 sentences using correct grammar e.g. a capital letter at the beginning of each sentence, finger spaces between each word and a full stop at the end of each sentence.</p>	<p>Complete 'My News' weekly diary entry (template provided).</p> <p>Handwriting/formation activities - Start at the beginning of the alphabet and practice writing 3 different letters per day. Please practice small and capital letters.</p>	<p>Number Stories to 10 - Complete 2 number stories. Use objects at home for a visual aid if required.</p> <p>Shape - Explore and talk about shapes in the environment. For example, <i>shapes of leaves, containers, windows.</i></p> <p>Investigate and talk about the properties of shapes, for example, <i>those that roll/do not roll, those with straight edges/curved edges.</i></p>	<p>Art - Junk art construction, build and make models with 3D shapes. Create pictures and patterns with 2D shapes. Card included in learning at home pack 2 for Father's Day.</p> <p>Create and explore patterns through Summer art activities. For example, paint/draw/colour/make butterflies, bees, flowers, gardens, the beach pictures, etc. Children can also create storyboard backgrounds to retell a story they have been reading at home.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Choose 3 different words and write 3 new sentences using correct grammar.</p> <p>Play a range of phonics games online focusing on the sounds for this week. For example 'Buried Treasure' - www.phonicsplay.co.uk, www.topmarks.com or www.starfall.com</p>	<p>Read a book from home or an online eBook. Complete comprehension questions.</p> <p>Include questions about the setting, the characters, the meaning of the story and missing word activities.</p>	<p>Doubles to 10. Use objects at home as a visual aid if required.</p> <p>Data Handling - Sort collections of random materials. For example, <i>cutlery, socks, fruit. etc.</i> Talk about the way the child has sorted the collection and why.</p> <p>Children ask family members questions and record information. For example, <i>favourite food, drink, eye colour, movie, etc.</i></p> <p>Children then complete a simple pictogram or bar chart to show results. Ask questions about completed chart.</p>	<p>PE - Explore movement through space during indoor and outdoor play activities. Explore body space through different types of movement, for example, <i>curling and stretching, high knees, star jumps, etc.</i> Use a range of positional words, for example, <i>in front of, behind, across, beside, between.</i> Follow/give directions from/to a partner for simple movements, for example, <i>two steps forward, one step backwards.</i> Play 'Simon Said'. Try 'PE with Joe' every Monday - Friday at 9am live on YouTube - 'The Body Coach TV' - 30-minute workout for all ages Use www.cosmickids.com for yoga based classes.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Choose 3 different words and write 3 new sentences using correct grammar.</p> <p>Play a range of phonics games online focusing on the sounds for this week. For example 'Buried Treasure' - www.phonicsplay.co.uk, www.topmarks.com or www.starfall.com</p>	<p>Write a character profile, storyboard or an alternative ending on a book you have read this week.</p> <p>Character Profile - Draw a picture of the character, make a list of describing words to describe the character, write 4 sentences about the character.</p> <p>Storyboard - write a beginning, middle and end to a story you have read. Remember to include a setting and a description of the characters (template provided).</p> <p>Alternative ending - think about the end of a story you have read this week. Use the characters and setting and write your own new ending to the story.</p>	<p>Adding 1, 2 or 3 to a number up to 20.</p> <p>Time - Talk about significant times on the clock. For example, <i>breakfast time, dinner time, bed time.</i></p> <p>Days of the week, Months of the year, the 4 Seasons, special times or occasions each week/month. For example, <i>Father's Day, birthdays, anniversaries, family celebrations/events.</i></p>	<p>PDMU - Discuss with your children the importance of staying positive.</p> <p>Relate to the messages/topics discussed from our 'Wellbeing Wednesday' programme delivered in school. These messages are in your child's PDMU book.</p> <p>Mindfulness colouring activities can also be completed.</p> <p>Talk about the importance of family, friends and neighbours - how we can be kind and help each other.</p>
Thursday	<p>Choose 3 different words and write 3 new sentences using correct grammar.</p> <p>Play a range of phonics games online focusing on the sounds for this week. For example 'Buried Treasure' - www.phonicsplay.co.uk, www.topmarks.com or www.starfall.com</p>	<p>Research a topic/area from 'Watery World' connected learning grid online and discuss what the children already know.</p> <p>Complete an 'explosion chart' on research carried out to prepare for writing a report - Include a basic labelled diagram, an opening sentence, 3-4 facts and a closing sentence (template provided).</p>	<p>Subtracting 1, 2 or 3 to a number up to 20.</p> <p>Money - become familiar with coins in everyday use.</p> <p>Talk about different ways we can pay for goods, for example, <i>cash, cheque, credit/debit card.</i></p> <p>Use their number skills in role play shopping activities.</p>	<p>RE - Talk about nature and new life beginning/blossoming in Spring/Summer. For example, <i>leaves on trees, new baby animals, flowers beginning to bloom, changes in weather, sounds of animals or birds we hear outside, how the days are brighter for longer, etc.</i> Draw/paint/colour a picture.</p> <p>Grow in Love - Use log in sheet from our school website to access the free resources below - www.growinlove.ie</p> <p>Grow in Love - Primary 2 - Theme - Seasonal Lessons - Mary</p> <p>Grow in Love - Primary 2 - Theme - St Brigid and the Spring</p>
Friday	<p>Complete Friday Check Up on a variety of words listed on the 3 week spelling list.</p>	<p>Write a report on this topic/area - Children will use their explosion chart from yesterday to help them (template provided).</p>	<p>Complete Friday Check Up focusing on mental maths activities and strategies from during the week.</p> <p>Problem solving activities/challenges.</p>	<p>ICT - Keep up to date with coding skills using the 'Scratch' help sheet provided earlier. Use our useful website or apps sheet to explore a range of educational activities for literacy, numeracy and topic work.</p>
