Who are we and what do we do?

Mary Queen of Peace PTA began in October 2016.

Our aim is to support our school community in whatever way we can:

- * We apply for grants to support the purchase of larger scale play equipment and IT resources for our children.

What we have done over the last 2 years:

- * Awarded the Rathsherry Community Benefit fund grant to purchase 9 iPads

- * Run Halloween Hampers and a Halloween Scary Scarecrow Competition fundraiser
- * Christmas 2020, we funded alongside GDCRA/Glenravel Together, Community wide Santa Visits for the parish.
- * Received a NACN grant to provide Warm, Well and Connected Support Packs for every child in school including Easter treats
- * Awarded PHA/NACN Making Life Better Grant to provide 'Fresh Little Minds' & 'The Sunshine Project' workshops/training to support Wellbeing Wednesdays in school
- * Provided P7 confirmation and end of year treats
- * Worked alongside GDCRA/Glenravel Together to provide a Drive Through Movie event for the community.
- * Arranged Summer Hamper Fundraising raffle.
- * Arranged a Uniform exchange fundraiser
- * Ongoing Easy Fundraising from Online shopping.
- * Fireside Christmas Quiz and Christmas Treats.
- * Halloween Family Fun Evening fundraiser
- * Halloween Hampers fundraiser
- * Summer Disco and Summer hamper
- * Cash for Clobber
- * Support and funding at school events in 2019: Confirmation, First Holy Communion & Grandparents Day.
- * Christmas Bingo fundraiser
- * Fundraisers to support the provision of a new school Maths Scheme
- * And grant funded provision of Isak 9 maths cubes for use in the classroom.
