GIFT- Code of Conduct

For Young People- Gift Members

We agree to:

- Come to GIFT Programme with a willingness to participate.
- Show respect to everyone in the GIFT programme and other people who will be using the Youth Centre (No running within the building, shouting or swearing. The GIFT programme promotes respect and challenges all forms of bullying.)
- Attend all sessions and arrive on time- on arrival to register their attendance.
- To remain in the building until the session is complete.
- Respect the Parish property and GIFT resources.
- Never tamper with the fire extinguishers, block the stairs or fire exits.

For Parents/Guardians

- To bring their children to the venue (refer to programme for detail) at the required time.
- To collect your children at the end of each session- 1PM. The GIFT programme can only be responsible for its members during the time that the programme is facilitated 10AM – 12noon.
- To complete the consent form.
- To familiarise themselves with the Code of Conduct.
